**Notice of Apportionment for California State Preschool Contractors
Fiscal Year 2022–23**

The State Controller and State Treasurer are hereby notified that an apportionment has been made from state Proposition 98 funds pursuant to Section 1 of Assembly Bill (AB) 110 (Chapter 4, Statutes of 2023) to California State Preschool Program (CSPP) contractors to provide a temporary rate increase. AB 110 authorizes the California Department of Education to issue temporary rate increases to CSPP contractors that exceed the existing reimbursement rates.
